Privacy Policy

The **Fiona Wood Foundation** (the Foundation) values your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal information. This privacy policy outlines our ongoing obligations to you regarding how we collect, use, store, and disclose personal information.

We have adopted the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (the Privacy Act), as well as other applicable laws protecting privacy, including State and Territory health information legislation.

By providing personal information to the Foundation, you consent to its collection, use and disclosure of that personal information on the terms of this privacy policy and any other contractual or other arrangements that apply between us (if any).

What is personal information and why do we collect it?

Personal information is information or an opinion that identifies an individual. Examples of personal Information we collect include names, addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses, dates of birth, financial records, records of previous support and donations, records of e-commerce orders, records of interactions and communications with and relating to us, and other information such as health-related information pertaining to the activities of the Foundation.

This personal Information is obtained in many ways, including through correspondence, telephone, email, via our website (www.fionawoodfoundation.com), media and publications, social media, cookies and other publicly available sources.

We collect your personal information for the primary purpose of providing our services to you, providing information to our clients, e-commerce, and marketing. We may also use your personal information for secondary purposes closely related to the primary purpose in circumstances where you would reasonably expect such use or disclosure.

You may unsubscribe from our mailing/marketing lists at any time by contacting us in writing. In general, the Foundation collects information directly from the relevant individual. On occasion, the Foundation may need to collect information about an individual from third parties, including parents, carers, guardians or other third-party information sources. The Foundation will do this if the individual, or in the case of a patient, their guardian or carer, has consented for it to collect, use or disclose the information in this way, or where it is not reasonable or practical for the Foundation to collect this information directly from the individual.



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When we collect personal information we will, where appropriate and where possible, explain to you why we are collecting the information and how we plan to use it.

How we use and disclose personal information

The Foundation uses and discloses the personal information it collects to:

1. Process payments and communicate with its donors and supporters, including sending them information (which may be by phone, post, email or other electronic means).
2. Communicate with donors and supporters, patients and their family members and employees (including responding to queries and complaints) and distribute its publications, conduct fundraising events and raise awareness about its fundraising activities and mission.
3. Conduct its general business activities, including interacting with contractors and service providers, assessing and funding grant applications, billing and administration including measuring and assessing the level of support the Foundation receives and the effectiveness of our fundraising activities and assessing applicants for positions with the Foundation.

The Foundation may also disclose the personal information of patients to their family members or guardian to discuss stories about their experience with the Foundation, when permission to share has been granted.

The Foundation may, with your permission, forward patient stories to third parties to help promote their fundraising efforts and refer to patient stories in our publications, including on our website.

Security of your personal information

Your personal information is stored in a manner that reasonably protects it from misuse and loss and from unauthorised access, modification or disclosure. However, the Foundation reminds you that the Internet is not a secure environment, and although all care is taken, it cannot guarantee the security of information you provide to the Foundation via electronic means.

Cookies

The Foundation's website may use cookies for site administration purposes. Cookies are very small files that a website uses to identify you when you come back to the site and to store details about your use of the site. Cookies are not malicious programs that access or damage your computer. If you wish not to take advantage of cookies, you may have your browser not accept them, although this may disable or render unusable some of the features of the Foundation's website.



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No personal information is collected through the Foundation's use of cookies, rather, the patterns of usage of visitors to the website may be tracked to provide improved service and content based on an aggregate or statistical review of user site traffic patterns.

Re-marketing

We use third party vendor re-marketing tracking cookies, including the Google AdWords tracking cookie. This means we will continue to show ads to you across the internet, specifically on the Google Display Network (GDN). As always, we respect your privacy and are not collecting any identifiable information through the use of Google's or any other 3rd party remarketing system.

The third-party vendors, including Google, whose services we use – will place cookies on web browsers in order to serve ads based on past visits to our website. Third party vendors, including Google, use cookies to serve ads based on a user's prior visits to your website. This allows us to make special offers and continue to market our services to those who have shown interest in our service.

It is important to us that your personal information is up-to-date. We will take reasonable steps to ensure that your personal information is accurate, complete and up-to-date. If you find that the information we have is not up-to-date or inaccurate, please advise us as soon as practicable to update our records and ensure we can continue to provide quality services to you.
